There is no time as of yet when the wall will be coming as that will be determined the closer the time gets near. Cary stated there are 80 vendors confirmed and should be close to 500 motorcycles in town. This is an event the City of Vanceburg, Chamber of Commerce and the Vanceburg Lions Club has been working on for several months now.




