**Updates:**

Mayor Blankenship stated that the Vietnam Traveling Wall will be coming to Vanceburg on Friday May 20, 2022. The City of Vanceburg along with the Vanceburg Lions Club and Chamber of Commerce has been working together on what will be the 1<sup>st</sup> Annual MayFest. This event will take place on Saturday May 21, 2022 with the Vietnam Traveling Wall being on display. There will be artisans and food vendors throughout the 1 day event.

Mayor Blankenship stated he had gotten a phone call from Sargent Stone from the JROTC wanting to help clean up some property here in the City. He thought that the Woodlawn Cemetery could benefit from that. On April 16<sup>th</sup> the High School JROTC is going to clean monuments, mow and clean up the area starting at 9:00 am. Should be about 30-75 students.

Mayor Blankenship stated that the 2 new Ford Explorer Police Cruisers were sitting out front of the building if any of the council members wanted to view them. The City also had purchased a 2001 GMC Dump Truck since the March council meeting and it is out front for council to view as well. Employee Laddie Biles was in attendance and stated that the dump truck has already been in use and is working out great for our city.
