**Electric Plant Board Report:**

Councilwoman Patton gave an update on the Electric Plant Board working with Acumen, to discuss the strategy moving forward for electricity starting in June 2025. Superintendent Bill Tom Stone met with representatives back on April 4<sup>th</sup> to discuss the RFQ process that will happen in May. The thought is that we need to start narrowing the field to one provider that will deliver electricity to Vanceburg after the contract with AEP/KY. power has ended. There are still many questions left to answer.

Councilwoman Patton said the Scotts Branch project has been advertised to bid for a directional boar.

**Old Business:**

**Sanitation Bids:** Mayor Blankenship asked if the council was ready to accept a bid. Councilwoman Pugh asked Brian Parson if his bid on the dumpsters was for \$5,000.00 for all dumpsters and Brian stated that it was. Brian also stated the customers would be charged the same rate till the end of this year. Next year the trash rate would change to \$18.00 for a regular customer and \$15.00 for a senior citizen. Councilwoman Pugh asked Rumpke if they offer recycling, and they do. Councilwoman Cantu asked what day would trash pickup be, both Brian Parson and Rumpke stated they would keep the current schedule. Councilwoman Patton made a motion to **accept the Sanitation Bid for Garbage Pickup Franchise and Equipment from Brian Parsons in the amount of \$265,000.00 for 5 years.** Councilwoman McCann seconded the motion.

Mayor Blankenship appreciated all the volunteers who showed up and for their hard work that was done.






